

256 - Update Bulk or O/R Qty

This code reads a .csv file to update the bulk/warehouse bulk files and/or the O/R file. After selecting the file to update, the code prompts for the user to indicate if the import quantity is to add (increase), subtract (decrease), or replace. The replace function only works when updating the O/R for draw and return quantity. When it updates the bulk files, the distributed amount is decreased/increased by the quantity in the .csv file. When it updates the O/R file, it decreases/increases the O/R draw, reorder, or draw and return quantity. The option to update draw and return quantity, only works with updating the O/R File, not the Bulk File. If the reorder field is selected, the quantity will be set to zero if a negative amount occurs. The draw option will allow a negative draw to result. The number of records updated displays on the screen. The .csv file is deleted from the query directory after the code runs.

The import file must be named BULK.CSV and is put in the /u/dps/mag/query directory.

BULK.CSV file layout if updating draw (D) or reorder (R):

256 - UPDATE BULK OR O/R QTY

Do You Want to Continue (Y/N)? : Key Y to continue with the update. Key N to return to the main menu

Update Bulk / O/R (B/O)? The default is B to update the Bulk. Key O to update the O/R.

If B is selected, the following displays.
Decrease or Increase Qty (D/I)? This displays if B is keyed to update Bulk. The default is D to decrease the Bulk distributed amount. Key I to increase the Bulk distributed amount.

If O is selected, the following displays.

Replace, Decrease, Increase Qty (R/D/I):

The default is D for decrease. Key R to replace.
Key I to Increase.

Update Draw/Reorder/Draw & Ret (D/R/A)?:

The default is D for draw. Key R for reorder.
Key A for draw/return.
