

## **SmarTerm Default File Transfer Process**

The folder that SmarTerm uses for incoming and outgoing file transfers is buried deep underneath the Persoft directory, to make the your electronic file easier to locate you should create a new folder in the root of your C: drive and change the properties of SmarTerm to use your new folder as the default.

1. Double Left Click on **My Computer** icon in the Windows Desktop.
2. Double Left Click on the **[C:]** drive icon
3. You should now be in the root level of the C: drive or local drive. Right Click and a menu will display. Highlight **New**, a second menu will open . Highlight **Folder**, and left click. A new folder will be created, change the name of the folder from “New Folder” to “File Transfers”.
4. In SmarTerm, select **\Properties\Global Options** from the toolbar.
5. The Global Options dialog box displays, select the **File Locations** tab.
6. Highlight **File Transfers**, then press the browse button. In the browse window, click on the C: icon, then highlight the folder you created above. Press OK. Press OK.

## **Z MODEM - Transfer files from RS6000 to Direct Serial Connected PC**

1. In SmarTerm go to the menu at top as follows ‘Properties->File Transfer Protocols’, select **ZMODEM**
2. In SmarTerm go to the menu at top as follows ‘Properties->ZMODEM’ Properties, Check the option for ‘**Allow Automatic Downloads**’ as well as ‘**Determine Automatically**’.
3. Log into the DPS system as a non-FacetTerm user. **\*\*\*You cannot be in FacetTerm while doing this procedure\*\*\***
4. At the DPS Main Menu, key **AIX**
5. At the AIX prompt "home/username>", key ‘**sz /u/dps/mag/export/KW1211**’ or the path to the directory that the file is in followed by the filename. In this example /u/dps/mag/export is the directory and KW1211 is the file name.
6. This will start the file transfer to your PC, when complete the file will be found in the “File Transfer” folder set up above. From here you may e-mail the file to the appropriate parties by attaching it to your e-mail.
